**INFORMATION SHEET** Dear Colleagues!

Tomsk State University invites you to participate in VIII National petrographic conference with participation of Foreign Scientists "Petrology of magmatic and metamorphic complexes", which will be held in Tomsk (Russia) on November 28-December 3, 2016 on the base of Petrography Department of the Faculty of Geology and Geography. The conference was held in 2000 for the first time and became a great opportunity for Russian researchers and Siberian ones in particularly to exchange great amount of materials/data resulting in collaborative projects and/or papers. Within this conference, foreign scientists and researchers from many different countries participate actively; therefore, main languages for the event are Russian and English. In order to deliver all information sufficiently, an important requirement for the conference participants is submission of an abstract: up to one page (in English) for Russian speakers, and up to half a page (in English also) for foreign speakers, which will be further translated into Russian by organization committee.

Within the conference, young researchers will have opportunity to attend workshops held by leading specialists from Canada, Spain, and other countries. The best works written by young researchers under the age of 35 will be supported by Tomsk State University grants reserved for methodical and analytical research on the base of the center of shared equipment "Geochemistry of natural systems" at TSU. These papers will also be published in a brand new journal "Geosphere research" founded by the Faculty of Geology and Geography of TSU in 2016.

- Topics suggested for the conference:
- 1. Magmatism of crust and mantle
- 2. Formation analysis, geodynamics, and geological correlation
- 3. Metamorphism and metamorphic-type mineral formation
- 4. Methodology for studying matter composition of geological systems
- 5. Structural analysis in geological research
- 6. Metallogeny of crystal and sedimentary complexes

By the date of the conference beginning, a series of papers shall be published as an Almanac of scientific papers. All materials for publication shall be prepared in accordance with requirements listed below and submitted to organization committee before **October 23, 2016**. Organization fee of 1000 RUB per paper is applied (for publishing in the Almanac). Undergraduate and postgraduate students, as well as young researchers (under the age of 35) are exempt from this fee. Foreign colleagues, who attend conference, can pay on-site during first day registration. Others participating remotely are also exempt from this fee.

## Deadlines for submission of papers for publication in the Almanac

All papers must be submitted to organization committee before **October 10, 2016**. Works submitted after the deadline might not be included in the Almanac. ## **Requirements to papers/proceedings**

**Volume** of a paper shall be up to 10 typed pages, A-4 format, <u>including figures</u>, tables, references, and abstract in <u>English or Russian</u>.

**Text** shall be submitted in a separate MS WORD file. Font can be Times New Roman or Symbol, Font size -12, line spacing 1.0, hyphenation is not allowed, justified alignment, tab stops of 5 MM, formulas can be inserted in the text using Microsoft Equation. All formatting shall be done using MS WORD only. Title of the presentation, author's name and organization shall be aligned in the center and separated from the text by a blank line. Tables and figures shall not be inserted in the test and submitted as separate files. References to figures and tables in the text shall be listed in parentheses in Italic: (*Fig. 1*) or (*Fig. 1 a, b; Fig. 2*), (*Table 2*) or (*Fig. 1; Table 2, 3*). References to publications shall contain author's last name and year of publication: (Ivanov, 1999), (Ivanov, Petrov, 2000), (Sidorov et.al., 2001), (Correlation..., 1999), (Ivanov, 1999, 2000; Petrov, 2001).

**Tables** shall be submitted as separate MS WORD files (with titles and footnotes) using Times New Roman or Symbol font with size 10 and line spacing 1.0, hyphenation is not allowed. Tables must be enabled for editing.

**Figures** shall be submitted as \*.tif with resolution of 300 dpi, \*.JPEG files are allowed for pictures only. In cases when figures are made using vector graphics editors (CorelDRAW, Free Hand, etc.), we recommend emailing source files along with \*.TIF ones. Figures must be black and white.

**Figure captions** shall be submitted in a separate MS WORD file using Times New Roman or Symbol font with size 10 and line spacing 1.0, hyphenation is not allowed.

Organization Committee reserves the right to decline presentations, which do not resemble modern scientific concepts and/or do not meet above requirements and deadline.
