As last year, to accommodate a growing meeting, there are options for presenters:

- 1) Full Talk (15 minutes with 5 minutes of discussion);
- 2) Lightning Talk (4 minutes + 2 minutes of discussion);
- 3) Poster Presentation.

Please indicate your preference of presentation type with your submission. All abstracts will be peer reviewed for scientific rigor and interest to the intelligence community. Acceptance decisions will be announced on or shortly after April 30.

The conference registration fees this year have been reduced for all participants due to additional funding available to local hosts.

Students, whose abstracts are accepted for poster or talk can apply for the ISIR Travel Award (deadline May 5). See the STUDENT AWARDS section of the conference page for more details). Awards will be announced on May 10.

In addition to the main conference, students and early career researchers have an opportunity to attend a satellite International Summer School “Interdisciplinary Approaches to the Study of Intelligence”(July 12 - 14).

Attendance is free but the number of places is strictly limited, so apply early (registration 30 April- 16 May). All details are on the conference page.

As participants from many countries will require a visa to enter Russia, we advise attendees to make their travel arrangements as soon as possible. We have assembled a wealth of information about visas and other practicalities on the main conference page, including guide to applying for the visa.
